A Quick Guide to Understanding CVC 21202

California Vehicle Code 21202 Is the bicyclist... If the answer to ANY question is YES: ...riding the same speed **CVC 21202 does NOT require** YES or faster than other traffic? the bicyclist to ride far right. NO ...passing a slow or YES Passing on the left is a basic rule of movement. stopped vehicle? NO ...preparing to turn left? YES It's illegal and unsafe to turn left from the right edge. NO **12ft** Normal width is NOT shareable ... in a lane that is YES **14ft** Shareable with cars and too narrow to share? small SUVs at low speeds **16ft** Shareable with most vehicles NO 12 14ft 16^{ft} ...encountering unsafe YES Unsafe conditions include (but are not limited to): conditions on the edge? Parked cars and the door zone, obstructions, pavement defects, broken glass and debris, standing water, ice, poor sight lines. NO ...approaching a driveway YES Anywhere right turns are authorized. or intersection?



If the answer to ALL questions is NO: The bicyclist must ride as far to the right as practicable.
